Nelipots in Nature By-Laws

Article I – Name and Purpose

Section 1: Name

The name of the organization shall be *Nelipots in Nature*.

Section 2: Mission

Nelipots in Nature is a nature-based educational collective dedicated to enriching the lives of children and families through immersive, child-led, outdoor learning experiences. We foster community, sustainability, and holistic development while honoring diverse cultures and languages.

Article II – Membership

Section 1: Eligibility

Membership is open to families and individuals who support the mission and values of Nelipots in Nature and agree to abide by its rules and code of conduct.

Section 2: Rights and Responsibilities

Members are expected to participate in activities, support community events, and maintain respectful behavior aligned with the group's values.

Article III - Board Members

Section 1: Role

The Board Members (referred to as "the Board") shall be responsible for overseeing the strategic direction, governance, and financial well-being of Nelipots in Nature.

Section 2: Composition

The Board Officers shall consist of the following positions:

Section 3: Duties of Officers

- **President** Provides overall leadership; presides over meetings; ensures alignment with the mission.
- Vice President Supports the president and assumes leadership in their absence.
- Secretary Maintains meeting minutes, attendance records, and helps respond to emails.

- Accountant Manages financial records, budgeting, and compliance with applicable laws.
- **Historian** Documents the organization's activities and milestones and posts recaps on social media.
- Educational Coordinator Oversees curriculum planning and pedagogical approaches.
- Spanish Teacher / Science Teacher / Kindergarten / Preschool / Baby & Mini Nelis Teachers Lead educational instruction in assigned areas.
- Membership Chair Manages membership enrollment, renewals, and engagement.
- Librarian Gathers reading materials for all age groups and Spanish class.
- **Nutritionist** Buys and prepares healthy food items for each class.
- **Social Media Coordinator** Manages digital communication and social media platforms.
- **Events Coordinator** Plans and executes group events, field trips, and community gatherings.
- Community Outreach Coordinator Plans and executes philanthropic events.
- Fundraising Coordinator Organizes fundraising events and initiatives.
- Materials Coordinator Oversees supplies, inventory, and equipment.
- Merchandise Coordinator Designs and manages branded merchandise and sales.

Section 4: Term of Office

Board members shall serve one-year terms, renewable by vote or consensus of members.

Section 5: Meetings

The Board shall meet monthly, or as needed, to review organizational matters. A quorum (50% of Board members) is required to vote on official business.

Article IV – Committees

Committees may be formed to address specific tasks such as curriculum development, events, or safety protocols. Each committee shall be chaired by a Board member and may include general members.

- Materials and Merchandise Coordinators
- Librarians
- Fundraising Committee
- Teacher Assistants
- Membership Committee helps advertise Nelipots and helps new families during classes
- Events Committee Help set up and take down for field trips, clubs, & events. May also help as chaperones to round up the kids, check-in families, or pass out items.

Article V – Decision Making

Decisions shall be made by majority vote of the Board unless otherwise specified. In cases of tied votes, the President shall cast the deciding vote.

Article VI – Amendments

These by-laws may be amended by a two-thirds vote of the Board, followed by notification to the general membership.

Article VII – Conflict of Interest

Board members must disclose any conflicts of interest and recuse themselves from related votes or decisions.

Article VIII – Dissolution

In the event of dissolution, any remaining assets shall be distributed to a like-minded educational or nonprofit organization, as decided by the Board.
